MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships : main objectives

- Enhance the creative and innovative potential of researchers holding a PhD, wishing
 to acquire new skills through advanced training, international, interdisciplinary and
 inter-sectoral mobility
- Open to **excellent researchers**, including researchers wishing to **reintegrate** in Europe, researchers who are **displaced by conflict** as well as researchers with high potential aiming for a **career restart in research**
- Encourage researchers to work on research and innovation projects in the nonacademic sector







European Postdoctoral Fellowships



Mobility towards an organisation based in a Member State or an associated country to Horizon Europe

Duration: from 12 to 24 months





Applicant:

- Nationality is not a criterion
- Must be in possession of a doctoral degree
- **Up to 8 years** of research experience







Global Postdoctoral Fellowships

Mobility towards an organisation based in a Third country and a mandatory return in a Member State or an associated country to Horizon Europe


Duration: from 24 to 36 months

Outgoing phase: 12 to 24 months

Mobility rule: The researcher cannot have resided or carried out his/her main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the third country of the outgoing phase for more than 12 months in the **36 months** immediately **prior** to the call deadline.

Applicant:

- Nationals or long-term residents of a Member State or an associated country
- Must be in possession of a doctoral degree
- **Up to 8 years** of research experience

Optional secondments & placements

	Secondment (<u>during</u> the fellowship)	Placement (after the fellowship)
Maximum duration	EPF: up to 1/3 of the standard project duration GPF: up to 1/3 of the outgoing phase	Up to 6 months
When?	EPF: at any time during the standard project duration GPF: cannot take place during the mandatory 12 month return period to the host organisation in a MS or AC. However, a maximum of three months of such secondments can be spent at the start of the project at the beneficiary (or associated partners linked to the beneficiary) before going to the associated partner for the outgoing phase. This period is counted as an integral part of the outgoing phase.	Additional period that takes place after the standard duration of the fellowship
Where?	Any country worldwide	Member State or associated country
Sector?	Any sector	Non-academic sector only
Commitment letter?	Not required	Not required

To keep in mind...

- Proposals involving the same recruiting organisation (and for Global Postdoctoral Fellowships also the associated partner hosting the outgoing phase) and individual researcher submitted for the MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships 2022 call and having received a score of less than 70% must not be resubmitted.
- Only one proposal per individual researcher can be submitted. In case of several
 proposals involving the same individual researcher, only the last submitted proposal will
 be considered eligible.
 - ♦ However, please note that the same supervisor and a host institution can be involved in more than one proposal in the same call.
- If proposals with the same research objectives and work plan are submitted by the same host organisation for different researchers, only the first submitted proposal will be considered eligible.





Create the proposal

- 1. Go on the European Commission portal Funding and Tenders Opportunities Portal
- 2. Create a EU Login account (Click on "Register")



- Once you are connected, go on the call webpage: MSCA Posdoctoral Fellowships 2024
- In the section [Start submission], select the type of submission (Global or European Fellowships). Then, click on « Start submission » in order to start your proposal.

Role of participating organisations

Beneficiary

- It signs the Grant Agreement
- It receives the funding from the European Commission
- It **recruits** the young research during the <u>whole duration</u> of the contract
- It is responsible of the project progress

Outgoing phase, secondment, non-academic placement

Host

institution


- Associated partner(s)
- It/They do not sign the Grant Agreement
- It/They do not receive the funding from the European Commission
- It/They bring(s) a complementary expertise
- It/They can host the outgoing phase of a Global Postdoctoral Fellowship, a secondment or a non-academic placement







Host institution : not your lab!









Evaluation procedure

- Evaluation by independent experts: 3 evaluators and one "rapporteur" by proposal
- Award criteria: excellence, impact and quality and efficiency of the implementation
- Each criterion is scored out of 5
- Applications scoring equal to or above 70% will be considered for funding (within the limits of the available budget)








PF 2021-2023 | Global data per year
