HAVE A GOOD TIME: It's not a course, but a moment of exchange with common languages. A time to talk about your personal stories, your hobbies and your linguistic aspirations

## DURING YOUR FIRST MEETING



- TANDEM SCHEDULE: Establish the frequency and duration of the tandem sessions
- TANDEM GOALS: Collaboratively outline the language goals you aspire to achieve



- WHERE TO MEET? Identify preferred locations for your practice sessions, considering both casual spots and cultural venues. For example, you could go on an outing together (an exhibition, an excursion, etc.)
- MEETING STRUCTURE: Develop an organized plan for the conduct of the tandem meetings

## STAYING MOTIVATED TOGETHER



- SCHEDULE: Establish a realistic timetable, factoring in your busy schedules and anticipating breaks
- TOPIC SELECTION: Explore mutually interesting topics for engaging and lively discussions
- BE PRACTICAL: Set milestones, whether you want to perfect your pronunciation, learn specific vocabulary or become more at ease in certain situations
- CULTURAL EXCHANGE: Recommend films, books, or songs in the target language to practice outside of meetings
