Erasmus+ Mobility 2024-2025

Overview

The Erasmus+ program, funded by the European Commission, supports student mobility at PSL University. It provides the opportunity to undertake a supervised mobility experience in one of the participating countries and to apply for an Erasmus+ grant.

As part of the *Sciences for a Sustainable World* program, you have the opportunity to complete an internship mobility lasting at least two months during your third year of study.

Terms and Conditions

Eligibility Criteria

- Be enrolled at PSL University
- The mobility must be approved by the program director (academic validation) and must align with your academic curriculum
- The mobility must be recognized in your degree program through the award of ECTS credits

Mobility to the United Kingdom and Switzerland is eligible but not prioritized, as these destinations are considered outside the European Union.

Activity

Internship mobility of at least two months, carried out in any organization, higher education institution, or company — with the exception of institutions, bodies, and agencies of the European Union.

Erasmus+ Grant

The Erasmus+ grant consists of two components:

- Contribution to living expenses
- Contribution to travel costs

Please note that this is a **partial contribution** and does not cover the full cost of your mobility stay. The living expenses grant varies depending on the destination country and its cost of living.

Flat-rate contributions for travel expenses are calculated based on distance brackets and the mode of transport chosen. Environmentally friendly means of transport include train, bus, and carpooling. This approach strongly encourages sustainable mobility, in line with PSL University's social and environmental responsibility policy.

An additional €150 per month is granted for students undertaking an internship mobility.

On top of this financial support, an inclusion supplement of €250 per month may be granted to students with fewer opportunities. The eligibility criteria for French higher education students are defined in the Bulletin Officiel de l'Éducation Nationale (BOEN).

Eligibility Criteria	Supporting Documents
Disability or long-term illness	Official MDPH decision, certificate of long-term illness, disability card, etc.
Residing in a rural revitalization zone (ZRR)	Proof of residence (electricity, water bill, etc.). If the name differs, include a sworn statement.
Residing in a priority urban area	Proof of residence (electricity, water bill, etc.). If the name differs, include a sworn statement.
Holder of a higher education scholarship (levels 6 and 7)	Scholarship award notification

Step	Actions	When
Before departure	Register on ARIANE and in the Registry of French Nationals Abroad Assess your language skills	March
Upon arrival	Send the signed arrival certificate from your host institution to Cathy Collins Payment Erasmus+ grant (80%)	During the first week at the host institution.
	In case of any changes to the learning agreement, submit an amendment to Cathy Collins	Throughout the mobility
End of mobility	Submit the signed departure certificate and internship certificate from the host institution to Cathy Collins	Upon return
	Complete the EU participant report (online survey)	Within 30 days of your return
	Payment of the remaining 20% of the Erasmus+ grant	After return
