SAAP – Who We Are. What We Do.

- ✳ The SAAP is the **grant and research support office of PSL University**, coordinated and hosted by the École Normale Supérieure (ENS).
- ✳ We bring together **9 participating institutions**: ENS, Université Paris Dauphine, ESPCI Paris, Observatoire de Paris, EPHE, École nationale des chartes, Mines Paris, EFEO, and Chimie ParisTech.
- ✳ The team covers **all research disciplines across PSL institutions**, including life sciences and humanities.
- ✳ SAAP is dedicated exclusively to accompanying researchers in the stage of **setting up**; financial follow-up is carried out by the employing institution.
- ✳ We support **all types of research funding applications** (regional, national, and international), with a particular focus on European programmes.

SAAP – Structure and Support

- ✳ Organised **by disciplinary portfolio**.
- ✳ Identification of funding opportunities using **monitoring tools** (e.g. ResearchConnect) and **dissemination** of funding calls and timelines.
- ✳ **Tailored support** for proposal preparation, including administrative and legal aspects, budget development, drafting assistance, and proofreading.
- ✳ Support for project follow-up, including extensions and substantial **administrative amendments** when required.

SAAP – Team

- ★ SAAP is a team consisting of **14 people**:
 - **The service director**
 - **9 dedicated members of staff**
 - 7 research project development officers
 - 1 communications officer
 - 1 support officer
 - **4 part-time experts** seconded from the partnership services of the various institutions.

✳ **During the summer 2026:** SAAP and your host institution will validate Part A (administrative form) and the Part B2 (with annexes).

- What → **WHILES** - Writing History in Lists, Enumerations, and Successions. How Short Thirteenth-century French Chronicles Shaped the Historical Culture of Late Medieval Elites.

- Where → **PSL - École Nationale de Chartes**
- When → Two applications: **2024** (87.40 %) and **2025** (96,60 %)
- How much → 2024: **One month and a half**, with a friend
2025: **Some days** in august



Feedback to the first rejection

Impact (3,9/5)

- Communication: “Limited number of specific measure”.
- Solutions:
 - I explicitly mention communication measures that I would undertake in any case:
 - *Regular uploading of articles, conference calls, and event programs to the open archive HAL, with link to Academia, ResearchGate and ORCID profiles.*
 - *Circulate information on project-related events through newsletters of French, Italian, and North American scholarly associations dedicated to medieval studies, of which I am a member (there was not enough space to mention specific examples).*
 - Plan to attend to pre-organisez events, such as:
 - Soirée des jeunes chercheurs du PSL.
 - MSCA European Researchers' Nights.

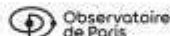



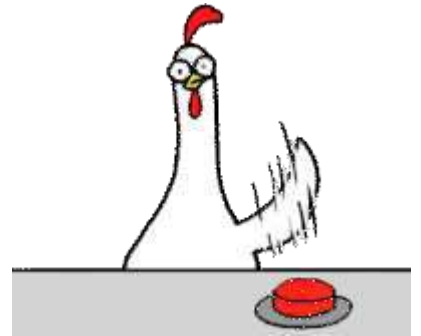

Submission tips

- ❖ **Deadline: 9 September 2026, 5 PM (CET)**
- ❖ You may **submit your application as many times** as you want before the deadline: each new submission will erase the previous one
- ❖ F&T portal can glitch at the deadline, **do not wait** until the last minute to submit.
- ❖ Results will be released around 5 months after the deadline – usually in February



Open science

- ✦ Quality of **open-science practices is central to the project's evaluation**, under both the Excellence and Impact criteria
- ✦ Research outputs must be “as open as possible, as closed as necessary”: all publications must be made available in a protected repository (HAL for France, Green route), or directly published in open access (Gold route, Diamond)
- ✦ **Data Management Plan (DMP)**: strategy as to how data will be collected, stored, shared and preserved
 - Deliverable due by Month 6 of the project
 - To be regularly updated
- ✦ **FAIR principles**: ensuring that scientific outputs can be shared, verified, and built upon by the wider scientific community
 - Findable
 - Accessible
 - Interoperable
 - Reusable

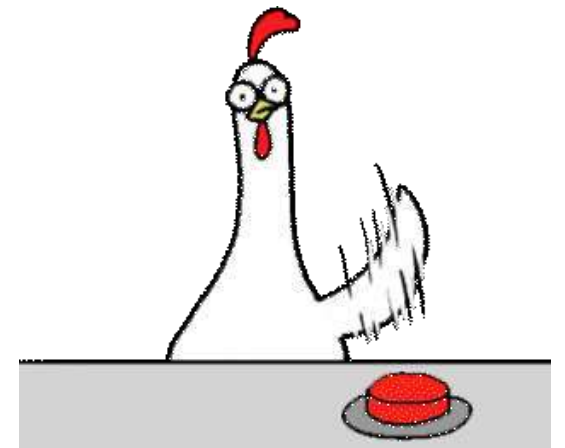

 - Deliverable due by Month 6 of the project
 - To be regularly updated
- ✦ **FAIR principles**: ensuring that scientific outputs can be shared, verified, and built upon by the wider scientific community
 - Findable
 - Accessible

Once your project has been selected for funding...

You will have **mandatory deliverables** to submit:

- **Mobility declaration** submitted **within 20 days** of the start of the research training activities and updated (if needed) via the Funding & Tenders Portal Continuous Reporting tool;
- **Career development plan** of the recruited researcher, submitted at the beginning of the action (**not later than 6 months after** its start) and updated if needed throughout the project;
- **Evaluation questionnaire** completed by the recruited researcher and submitted **at the end** of the research training activity; a **follow-up questionnaire** submitted **two years later**;
- **Data management plan** submitted within the **first 6 months** of the project;
- **Plan for the dissemination and exploitation of results** submitted towards the **end of the project**.

- Take care of the **deadlines**
- Carefully **read all call documents** (Work Programme, Guide for Applicant)
- Take care of **page limits**
- All parts of the proposal are **equally important**
- Don't wait **for the last moment** to submit your proposal!
