

Research project (Mandatory document) - Guidelines

- The project must present an innovative topic in computational social sciences, detailing its objectives, methodology and perspectives
- No more than 2,000 words (excluding academic references)
- In English

Please note:

The <u>Master's degree AI & society</u> offers funding opportunities for students especially interested in research and who might be interested in an academic career later on.

Those interested in the scholarship must indicate so in their application (see dedicated question online) and take specific care in presenting their research project. This project, which does not constitute a commitment to undertaking an academic career, will allow identifying the most promising students for research and provide them with additional support.

Procedure to Apply for an Excellence Scholarship | Academic year 2025-26

Eligibility criteria

The call is restricted to students applying for the Master's degree AI & society master's degree, Year 1, for the academic year 2025-26.

Selection criterion

The main criteria for awarding the scholarship will be academic excellence, research project and motivation.

Conditions of the Award

- By accepting the scholarship, the recipient commits to following the curriculum assiduously.
- For first year students in the master's degree benefiting from the scholarship to see it renewed in their second year, they will need to show strict commitment and attendance, but also to pass their first year.
- Students selected for an Excellence Scholarship will have 14 days to accept or decline the scholarship proposal definitively. If a student fails to respond within this timeframe or declines the admission proposal to the master's degree, she/he will be automatically refusing the scholarship.
- If declined by the student it is offered to, the scholarship will be awarded to the next ranked applicant.
